
PROVISIONAL BUDGET: Motioned by Schaffner, seconded by Hoyle to adopt the 2020 Provisional Budget in the following amounts: General Fund - \$2,202,763.00, County Road & Bridge Fund - \$3,384,858.00, Civil Defense Fund - \$66,405.00, RCW Fund - \$1,400.00, 911 Service Fund - \$50,000.00, 24-7 Sobriety Fund - \$4,550.00, M & P Relief Fund - \$15,500.00, and to set September 3, 2019, at 9:30 A.M. as the date and time for the first public hearing on adoption of the Provisional Budget as the 2020 Annual Budget. Motion carried.

TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION: Motioned by Hoyle, seconded by Grosz to allow Kyle Couchey to attend the Coroners training in Sioux Falls on October 7th & 8th, and to deny Kyle Couchey attending the Cannabis Impaired Driving in Sioux Falls on December 3rd. Motion carried.


