- **PROVISIONAL BUDGET:** Motioned by Hoyle, seconded by Thomas to increase the salaries of county employees by 21/2% for 2021 and adopt the Provisional Budget. Motion failed.
 - Motioned by Schaffner, seconded by Grosz to increase the salaries of county employees by 3% for 2021 and to adopt the 2021 Provisional Budget in the following amounts: General Fund \$2,205,991.00, County Road & Bridge Fund \$3,426,060.00, Civil Defense Fund \$47,754.00, RCW Fund \$1,400.00, 911 Service Fund \$50,000.00, 24-7 Sobriety Fund \$4,350.00, M & P Relief Fund \$15,500.00, and to set September 1, 2020, at 9:30 A.M. as the date and time for the first public hearing on adoption of the Provisional Budget as the 2021 Annual Budget. Motion carried.
