DOCUMENTS NEEDED WHEN APPLYING FOR YOUR DRIVER LICENSE OR IDENTIFICATION CARD

We will only be able to process your application if you have the following documents with you (this applies to <u>everyone</u> applying for a new, renewal or duplicate* driver license or ID card). <u>We cannot accept photo copies</u>. You will need a minimum (married women or anyone who has changed their name will need more) of 4 documents to receive a driver license or ID card. <u>Please read carefully:</u>

MUST HAVE ONE of the following to prove identity, date of birth, and lawful status:

- Certified U.S. birth certificate issued by county or state (no hospital birth-certificates)
- Valid unexpired U.S. passport
- Certificate of Naturalization
- Certificate of Citizenship Non-Citizens Need:
- Valid unexpired permanent resident card
- Valid unexpired employment authorization document
- Foreign passport with valid unexpired U.S. Visa with I-94

<u>Anyone who has changed their name since birth</u> (and does not have a valid U.S. Passport in their current name) needs to show proof of the name change(s). Acceptable documents for proof of legal name change are a <u>certified marriage certificate</u> (issued by a state vital records agency), a <u>certified adoption document</u>, or a <u>certified court order</u> authorizing a name change (such as a <u>divorce decree</u>). If you have been married multiple times you will need to provide proof of <u>all</u> name changes (unless you have taken back your maiden/birth name or hold a valid U.S. Passport).

MUST HAVE ONE document to prove <u>Social Security number</u>. The documents below are the <u>only</u> ones we can accept for proof of Social Security number (document must include name and full social security number). Please do not ask us to accept anything other than the documents below:

Social Security card

- Non-SSA 1099 Form
- Pay stub (must include name and full social security number)

W-2 Form
SSA 1099 Form

<u>MUST HAVE TWO</u> documents to prove your <u>residential/physical</u> address. A parent's proof of address is acceptable for a minor child. Please bring <u>two</u> of the documents listed below (each must contain your current address):

- Utility bill
- Credit card statement
- Pay stub or earnings statement
- Rent receipt
- Phone bill
- Transcript or report card from accredited school
- Bank statement

- Mortgage document
- Tax document
- Homeowners/renter's insurance policy
- · Other items will be reviewed by licensing personnel
- If you are unable to provide proof of residency please call 1-800-952-3696 or see our website at <u>www.dps.sd.gov</u> for exceptions.
- PO Box addresses are acceptable only in areas not assigned street or 911 addresses. Utility bills, cable bills and land-line phone bills usually list a "service-provided-at" address.

*If you have been issued a driver license or ID card since 12-31-09 (and you still have possession of that driver license or ID) U.S. citizens only need to provide your federally compliant driver license or ID and proof of residential address. Non-citizens must also show a valid U.S. Citizenship and Immigration document authorizing their presence in the United States.

Driver License or ID Card – New or Renewal (Class 1, 2, or 3) is \$20.00 Commercial Driver License – New or Renewal is \$25.00. (Endorsement Tests - \$10.00 each test) Duplicate Driver license or ID - \$10.00 Reinstatement Fees - \$50 to \$200.00
