September 25, 2018

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 A.M. on September 25, 2018 at the county courthouse. WEED CONTROL: Lenny Uhrich, Edmunds County Weed Supervisor, discussed the weed control plan for 2018 and 2019 in Edmunds County.

AUDIT REPORT: Dave Schlosser, SD Department of Legislative Audit, met with the Board to give a final report on the 2016 and 2017 audit for Edmunds County.

BID – MILLING SERVICES: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Hoyle to accept the bid for milling services which was awarded to Loiseau Construction Inc., in the amount of \$0.65 per square yard plus a \$2,500.00 mobilization fee, at the March 6, 2018, Brown County Commission meeting. Motion carried.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Thomas to approve and allow the chairman to sign the Emergency Management State and Local Agreement, between Edmunds County and the State of South Dakota, to provide funding for the development and maintenance of a local emergency management program in Edmunds County for the 2019 federal fiscal year. Motion carried.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Motioned by Thomas, seconded by Davis to enter into executive session at 10:20 A.M., according to SDCL 1-25-2(1). Motion carried. Executive session declared over at 10:30 A.M.

ORDINANCE – ZONING: Motioned by Hoyle, seconded by Davis, to approve the first reading of Edmunds County Ordinance No. 2018-9-2, Amendments to the Edmunds County Zoning Regulations, which rewrites current Sections 1901, 1902, and 1903 of Article 19 – Appeals. The second reading, for Ordinance No. 2018-9-2, will be on October 5, 2018. Roll call vote: Olson – yes, Grosz – yes, Davis – yes, Hoyle – yes, Thomas – yes. Motion carried.

2018 BUDGET: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Hoyle to approve the following Resolution #2018-9-1.

Whereas, (7-21-5 thru 13), SDCL provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall each year prepare a Provisional Budget of all contemplated expenditures and revenues of the County and all its institutions and agencies for such fiscal year and,

Whereas, the Edmunds County Board of Commissioners did prepare a Provisional Budget and cause same to be published by law, and


Whereas, due and legal notice has been given, to the meeting of the Edmunds County Board of Commissioners, for the consideration of such Provisional Budget and all changes, eliminations and additions have been made thereto.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That such Provisional Budget as amended and all its purposes, schedules, appropriations, amounts, estimates and all matters therein set forth, SHALL BE APPROVED AND ADOPTED AS THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURES FOR Edmunds County, South Dakota, and all its institutions and agencies for calendar year beginning January 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019, and the same is hereby approved and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Edmunds County, South Dakota, this 25th day of September, 2018. The Annual Budget so adopted is available for public inspection during normal business hours at the office of the county auditor Edmunds County, South Dakota. Taxes are levied by Edmunds County for the year January 1, 2019, through December 31, 2019, in the amount of \$3,037,086 which sets the 2018 Edmunds County Mill Levy at 2.135 dollars per \$1,000.00 of valuation, for taxes payable in 2019.
