January 19, 2021

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 A.M. on January 19, 2021 at the county courthouse. MINUTES APPROVED: Motioned by Schaffner, seconded by Preszler to approve the minutes of the January 5, 2021 regular meeting. Motion carried.

WEED & PEST BOARD MEETING: Motioned by Schaffner, seconded by Grosz to open the weed meeting at 10:25 A.M. Motion carried.

MINUTES APPROVED: Motioned by Thomas, seconded by Schaffner to approve the minutes of the December 8, 2020 Weed & Pest Board Meeting. Motion carried.

WEED CONTROL: Michael Jager, Edmunds County Weed Supervisor, discussed personnel and the weed control plan for 2021 in Edmunds County.

Motioned by Thomas, seconded by Schaffner to adjourn the weed meeting at 10:45 A.M. Motion carried.

4-H AGREEMENT: Motioned by Thomas, seconded by Preszler to approve and allow the chairman to sign the 2021 Memorandum of Understanding, between Edmunds County and SDSU Extension, allowing for a 4-H program in Edmunds County with a full time county employee to serve in the role of 4-H Youth Program Advisor and Extension Office Administrator. Motion carried.

HIGHWAY APPROACHES: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Preszler to approve the updated Application for Permit to Construct an Access Approach. Motion carried.

PLAT APPROVED: Motioned by Schaffner, seconded by Thomas to approve the following resolution:
