

The Edmunds County Sheriff's Office is seeking a responsible individual as a full-time deputy sheriff. Applicant must be 21 years of age, have a valid driver's license, be able to pass a background check, and pass a drug test. Applicant must be of good moral character. Starting wage for uncertified deputy is \$50,00 per year with an increase to \$51,304 after completion of the law enforcement academy. After 1 year of completion of the academy wage will increase to \$52,304. Certified Deputy Starting is \$51,304 per year with a \$1,000 raise after one year.
