March 7, 2023

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on March 7, 2023 at the county courthouse. Members present were: Dean Mehlhaff, Morris Grosz, Micheal J. Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve the Sheriff's hiring of Mande M. Meidinger, as full-time dispatcher to work in the Sheriff's Department, effective March 7, 2023, at a salary of \$19.91 per hour. Motion carried.


