April 25, 2023

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on April 25, 2023 at the county courthouse. Members present were: Dean Mehlhaff, Morris Grosz, Micheal J. REGISTER OF DEEDS: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to accept the Register of Deeds Statement of Fees for the month of March 2023 in the amount of \$7,618.90. Motion carried.

AIRCRAFT: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to approve and allow the chairman to sign the Permit Application allowing Dakota Air Spray, to operate, take off, or land aircraft on Edmunds County roads for the year of 2023, for the purpose of servicing said aircraft in preparation for aerial application of chemical or fertilizer materials. The aircraft shall be operated at their own risk, the county will assume no liability, proof of liability insurance has been filed with the Edmunds County Auditor and the aircraft operator must follow all Federal and State laws and regulations. Motion carried.

HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to approve and authorize Kyle Couchey to sign the 2024 Highway Safety Project Grant Agreement between Edmunds County and the South Dakota Office of Highway Safety, Federal award amount of \$50,670.90. Motion carried.

JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Preszler to approve and allow the chairman to sign the joint powers agreements, between Edmunds County and the Townships of Hillside, and Union for the rental of county blade/motor grader, snow removal equipment and an operator. Motion carried.

LIQUOR LICENSE: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Preszler to approve the 2023-2024 On-Off Sale Malt Beverage and On-Off Sale SD Farm Wines License renewal in the name of The Wakeside Bar & Grill LLC. Motion carried.

PLAT APPROVED: Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve the following resolution:

Be it resolved, by the Edmunds County Board of Commissioners, that the following plat, having been examined is hereby approved in accordance with the provisions of SDCL of 1967, Chapter 11-3, and any amendments thereof; plat of Weisser Addition in the NE¼ of Section 15, 122-70, Edmunds County, South Dakota.
