- AIRCRAFT: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve and allow the chairman to sign the Permit Application allowing Dakota Air Spray, to operate, take off, or land aircraft on Edmunds County roads for the year of 2024, for the purpose of servicing said aircraft in preparation for aerial application of chemical or fertilizer materials. The aircraft shall notify the Sheriff's Office, have flag person at each end, operated at their own risk, the county will assume no liability, proof of liability insurance has been filed with the Edmunds County Auditor and the aircraft operator must follow all Federal and State laws and regulations. Motion carried.
- **HEALTH INSURANCE:** Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Geditz to approve and allow the chairman to sign the Associated School Boards of South Dakota Health Benefits Fund Participation Agreement, with the South Dakota School District Benefit Fund, to provide health insurance for Edmunds County employees, offering \$1,000 and \$1,500 deductibles, effective July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. Motion carried.
- **HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve the 2025 Highway Safety Grant and to name it Highway Safety Grant in the minutes. Motion carried.

- JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Geditz to approve and allow the chairman to sign the joint powers agreements, between Edmunds County and the Townships of Cloyd Valley, Glover, Hosmer, Hudson, and Modena for the rental of county blade/motor grader, snow removal equipment and an operator. - LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER/JAIL: Corey Johnson GA Johnson Construction, Adam Kuehl HMN Architects, Thomas Grimmond Colliers Securities, and Matthew Beaner Huff Construction met with the Board to discuss the next steps in the process moving forward with construction of the new Edmunds County Law Enforcement Center and Jail.
 - DESIGN PLANS: Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Geditz to approve and allow the chairman to sign the agreement with HMN Architects Inc of Overland Park, Kansas for the design construction plans for the new Edmunds County Law Enforcement Center and Jail, with the architects compensation being 7.75% of the cost of the work. Motion carried.
 - RESOLUTION FINANCING NEW COUNTY FACILITY: The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Grosz, who moved its adoption: Resolution #2024-4-1, A Resolution Authorizing the Terms and Issuance of General Obligation Bonds, in an amount not to exceed \$7,400,000.00, for the construction of a new Jail, Dispatch Center, and Sheriff's Office within Edmunds County, South Dakota. The motion to adopt the resolution was seconded by Preszler. Roll call vote: Mehlhaff yes, Grosz yes, Geditz yes, Preszler yes, Thomas yes. Resolution adopted.
- **LIQUOR LICENSE:** Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to approve the 2024-2025 On-Off Sale Retail Malt Beverage and SD Farm Wine License renewal in the name of The Wakeside Bar & Grill LLC. Motion carried.
- ORDINANCE ZONING: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Geditz, to approve the second reading of Edmunds County Ordinance No. 2024-3-1, Amendment to the Edmunds County Zoning Regulations establishing guidelines and setbacks for hazardous liquid pipelines within the county. Roll call vote: Mehlhaff – yes, Grosz – yes, Geditz – yes, Preszler – yes, Thomas – yes. Ordinance adopted.
- **TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION:** Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Geditz to allow Gwen Geditz, Patricia Nigg, and Keith Schurr to attend the SD Association of County Officials Workshop in Pierre on May 15th-16th. Motion carried.
