IPSWICH, SOUTH DAKOTA

June 18, 2024

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on June 18, 2024 at the county courthouse. Members present were: Dean Mehlhaff, Morris Grosz, Micheal J. Geditz, Chad Preszler, and Timothy Thomas. Chairman Thomas called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Others present for portions of the meeting were: Audie Crouch, Peter Eng, Michael Jager, George Kessler, Dale Preszler, and Jonathan Waldner.

MINUTES APPROVED: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to approve the minutes of the June 5, 2024 regular meeting. Motion carried.

REGISTER OF DEEDS: Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Grosz to accept the Register of Deeds Statement of Fees for the month of May 2024 in the amount of \$5,997.70. Motion carried.

CLOSE HIGHWAY: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Mehlhaff to allow the Mina Lake Celebrations Committee to close County Highway #32 (old Hwy 12) from 3:00 p.m. to 11:30 p.m. on July 3, 2024, between Lucinda Lane and North Sunset Drive for fireworks display from county bridge. Motion carried.

JAIL: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to approve and allow the chairman to sign the Jail Agreement, with Roberts County, to provide housing for Edmunds County prisoners at a rate of \$115.00 adult per day and \$325.00 juvenile per day in the Roberts County facility. Motion carried.


POST-ELECTION AUDIT: The US Presidential and the SD House District 23 races in Precincts 3 and 4 were audited by the Edmunds County Post-Election Auditing Board on June 13, 2024. The Precinct 3 results were: Willaimson 5, Biden 4, Phillips 2, Peres-Serrato 1, Gosch 54, Moore 99, Wangsness 42. The Precinct 4 results were: Willaimson 3, Biden 11, Phillips 2, Peres-Serrato 3, Gosch 40, Moore 52, Wangsness 24.

Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to accept the Edmunds County primary post-election manual count audit results, which matched the June 4, 2024 election night machine count and the June 5, 2024 County canvass with 100% accuracy. Motion carried.
