IPSWICH, SOUTH DAKOTA

October 22, 2024

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on October 22, 2024 at the county courthouse. Members present were: Dean Mehlhaff, Morris Grosz, Micheal J. Geditz, Chad Preszler, and Timothy Thomas. Chairman Thomas called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Others present for portions of the meeting were: Andrea Carlson, Peter Eng, and Jonathan Waldner.

MINUTES APPROVED: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2024 regular meeting and the October 10, 2024 special meeting. Motion carried.

AUDIT REPORT: Jason Hill, SD Department of Legislative Audit, met with the Board to give a final report on the 2022 and 2023 audit for Edmunds County.

CHRISTMAS AT THE COURTHOUSE: The Wily Wizards 4H Club, asked permission to again sponsor a "Christmas at the Courthouse". Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to allow Christmas trees from different business, organizations, churches or individuals to be set up at the Edmunds County Courthouse for public viewing at designated times during the 2024 holiday season. Motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER: Corey Johnson - GA Johnson Construction, and Adam Kuehl - HMN Architects Inc, met with the Board via conference call and discussed the bids and reviewed the project.

LIQUOR LICENSES: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve the new Retail On-Off Sale Malt Beverage and SD Farm Wine License in the name of Baskets Unlimited LLC, Mina SD. Motion carried.

Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve the 2025 Retail On-Sale Liquor Licenses in the names of; Bowdle Golf Club, Myron's Refuge Grub & Pub, The Crossing LLC, and The Wakeside Bar & Grill LLC, and to approve the 2025 Package Off-Sale Liquor in the name of The M Station. Motion carried.

PLATS APPROVED: Motioned by Grosz, seconded by Geditz to approve the following resolution: Be it resolved, by the Edmunds County Board of Commissioners, that the following plats, having been examined are hereby approved in accordance with the provisions of SDCL of 1967, Chapter 11-3, and any amendments thereof; plat of Huax-Spear Subdivision in the E½ of Section 13, Township 123-66, plat of Holsing Addition in the NE¼ of Section 23, Township 121-68, and plat of Mitzel Second Subdivision in the E½ of the SE¼ of Section 33, Township 124-73, all in Edmunds County, South Dakota. Motion carried.

SUPPLEMENT BUDGET: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Preszler to supplement the Election Budget, in the amount of \$339.35, with SD State reimbursement for the June Primary Post-Election Audit costs, per SDCL 7-21-20.1. Motion carried.

TRAVEL AUTHORIZATION: Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Geditz to allow Peter Eng and Michael Varilek travel expenses to Sioux Falls for selection and purchase of a K-9 police drug dog from Next Level Canine Institute. Motion carried.
