IPSWICH, SOUTH DAKOTA
August 5, 2025

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on August 5, 2025 at the county courthouse. Members present were: Dean Mehlhaff, William Tweedy, Micheal J. Geditz, Chad Preszler, and Timothy Thomas. Chairman Thomas called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Others present for portions of the meeting were: Andrea Carlson, Garrett Heinz, Jonathan Waldner, and Morgan Weisser.

MINUTES APPROVED: Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Tweedy to approve the minutes of the July 22, 2025 regular meeting. Motion carried.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER: Adam Kuehl and Corey Johnson met with the board to give updates on the construction of the new Jail and Law Enforcement Center.

Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Preszler to approve Change Order proposal #1 to the construction costs of the new Law Enforcement Center – MDU Transformer Relocation in the amount of \$26,354.00. Motion carried.

PLAT APPROVED: Motioned by Mehlhaff, seconded by Tweedy to approve the following resolution: Be it resolved, by the Edmunds County Board of Commissioners, that the following plats, having been examined are hereby approved in accordance with the provisions of SDCL of 1967, Chapter 11-3, and any amendments thereof: Lot 3, Gisi Addition in the SE ¼ of Section 7, T122N, R67W, 5th P.M. Motion carried.


PROVISIONAL BUDGET: Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Mehlhaff to adopt the 2026 Provisional Budget in the following amounts: General Fund - \$4,813,837.00, County Road & Bridge Fund - \$3,466,945.00, Civil Defense Fund - \$98,172.00, RCW Fund - \$1,400.00, 911 Service Fund - \$80,000.00, 24-7 Sobriety Fund – \$4,950.00, M & P Relief Fund – \$38,000.00, Rural Access Infrastructure Fund - \$100,000.00, Debt Service Fund - \$490,000.00 and to set September 2, 2025, at 9:00 A.M. as the date and time for the first public hearing on adoption of the Provisional Budget as the 2026 Annual Budget. Motion carried.

TURKEY BARNS: Jeff Anderson met with the board in regard to noise complaints from neighbors of local turkey barns. Hybrid Turkeys has come up with a few solutions and will present back to the Board of Commissioners when finalized.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Preszler to enter into executive session at 11:27 a.m., according to SDCL 1-25-2(4). Motion carried. Executive session declared over at 11:35 a.m.
