LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER: Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Preszler to approve Change Order proposal #6 to the construction costs of the new Law Enforcement Center – Asphalt additions on 3rd Ave & 2nd St in the amount of \$41,970.00.

Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve Change Order proposal #9 to the construction costs of the new Law Enforcement Center – Base course and Geo textile fabric in the amount of \$18,683.25. Motion carried.

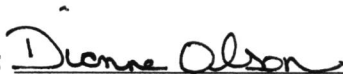
Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to adjourn the weed meeting at 9:42 a.m. Motion carried.
