

COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING  
IPSWICH, SOUTH DAKOTA  
April 28, 2026

The Edmunds County Board of Commissioners met at 9:00 a.m. on April 28, 2026 at the county courthouse. Members present were: William Tweedy, Micheal J. Geditz, Chad Preszler, Timothy Thomas and via teleconference Dean Mehlhaff. **MINUTES APPROVED:** Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Preszler to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2026 regular meeting and to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2026 Equalization meeting. Motion carried.

**ANNUAL REPORT:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Preszler to accept the 2025 Edmunds County Annual Report prepared according to SDCL 7-10-4. Motion carried.

**DISCUSSIONS:** Justin Baer was present for public forum and discussed the Road Transfer Agreement between Edmunds County, Hillside Township, and Pipestone Management.

**BUDGET SUPPLEMENT:** Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Tweedy to supplement the Sheriffs Budget, in the amount of \$372.56, with insurance money received, per SDCL 7-21-32.1. Motion carried.

**COMPUTERS:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Preszler to approve the Sheriff's purchase of five new computers for squad vehicles from Guardian in the amount of \$19,338.10. Motion carried.

**CONTRACTS:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Geditz to accept the contract with Modern Day Health for healthcare support services for Edmunds County Jail in the amount of \$150.00 per inmate bed per month. Motion carried.

**EMPLOYEES HIRED:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Geditz to approve the Sheriff's hiring of Brayden Buller as a full-time Jailer, at a salary of \$23.16 per hour, effective April 27, 2026. Motion carried.

Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Geditz to approve the Sheriff's hiring of Ashley Wandry as a full-time Jailer, effective May 11, 2026, at a salary of \$23.16 per hour. Motion carried.

**HEALTH INSURANCE:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Geditz to approve and allow the chairman to sign the Associated School Boards of South Dakota Health Benefits Fund Participation Agreement, with the South Dakota School District Benefit Fund, to provide health insurance for Edmunds County employees, offering \$1,000 and \$1,500 deductibles, effective July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. Also offering employee-funded Vision Insurance. Motion carried.

**INSURANCE:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Geditz to pay for full-time employees MASA medical transport solutions coverage at a rate of \$8.00 per month per employee. Motion carried.

**JOINT POWERS AGREEMENTS:** Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Tweedy to approve and allow the chairman to sign the joint powers agreements, between Edmunds County and

the Townships of Hudson and Madison for the rental of county blade/motor grader, snow removal equipment and an operator. Motion carried.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Geditz to approve Change Order #6 GMP to the construction costs of the new Law Enforcement Center – Credit for concrete sidewalk and unused portion of Winter Heat & Shelter Allowance in the amount of (\$5,182.00). Motion carried.

Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Preszler to approve Contingency Draw #8 to the construction costs of the new Law Enforcement Center – labor to install metal trim around laundry machines, labor to install readers/badges in cells and stainless washer/dryer trim in the amount of (\$1,466.68). Motion carried.

Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Tweedy to accept the quote from Guardian for Medication Manager in the amount of \$1,610.25 annually. Motion carried.

**PLATS APPROVED:** Motioned by Tweedy, seconded by Preszler to approve the following resolution: Be it resolved, by the Edmunds County Board of Commissioners, that the following plats, having been examined are hereby approved in accordance with the provisions of SDCL of 1967, Chapter 11-3, and any amendments thereof; Plat of Burgod First Addition in the SW ¼ of Section 8-T123N-R67W of the 5th P.M.; Plat of Heintzman First Addition in the SW ¼ of Section 33-T121N-R71W of the 5th P.M.; Plat of Heintzman Second Addition in the SE ¼ of Section 31, T121N-R71W of the 5th P.M. Motion carried.

**REGISTER OF DEEDS:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Tweedy to accept the Register of Deeds Statement of Fees for the month of March 2026 in the amount of \$7,074.10. Motion carried.

**TRAVEL AUTHORIZATIONS:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Geditz to allow Brittney Duvall and Sandra Northrop to attend Sales Ratio Training in Pierre on May 6<sup>th</sup>; and Sandra Northrop to attend the District Assessors Meeting in Faulkton on May 13. Motion Carried.

**ZONING BOARD:** Justin Davis, James Hoyle, and Jack Olson met with the board for a discussion on the open Zoning Board position.

Motioned by Mehlhaff to appoint James Hoyle to the Edmunds County Zoning Board. Motion died for lack of second.

Motioned by Geditz to appoint Jack Olson to the Edmunds County Zoning Board. Motion died for lack of second.

Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Tweedy to appoint Justin Davis to the Edmunds County Zoning Board, for a term ending December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2028.


Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Tweedy that nominations cease.

Roll call vote: Mehlhaff – no, Tweedy – yes, Geditz – yes, Preszler – yes, Thomas – yes.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Geditz to enter into executive session at 10:59 a.m., according to SDCL 1-25-2(1). Motion carried. Executive session declared over at 11:03 a.m.
