**BID - MILLING SERVICES:** Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Preszler to accept the bid for milling services which was awarded to Loiseau Construction Inc., in the amount of \$1.28 per square yard plus a \$3,500.00 mobilization fee, at the December 2, 2025, Harding County Commission meeting. Motion carried.

**BUDGET SUPPLEMENT:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to supplement the Sheriffs Budget, in the amount of \$340.50, with insurance money received, per SDCL 7-21-32.1. Motion carried.

**EMPLOYEES HIRED:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Geditz to approve the Sheriff's hiring of Chet Peterson as a full-time Jailer, at a salary of \$24.16 per hour, effective June 1, 2026. Motion carried.

**ESCROW AGREEMENT:** Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Preszler to approve the Escrow Agreement with Century Swine RE, LLC for 5 miles of road on 143<sup>rd</sup> Street. Motion carried.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER:** Motioned by Geditz, seconded by Mehlhaff to approve Contingency Draw #9 to the construction costs of the new Law Enforcement Center - Added framing above south wall of security electronics/taping at Vestibule 112, cut in 4 access panels. Architect requested hollow metal doors in lieu of wood doors at the following locations: 201, 203, 204, 206, 209, 210B, and IPS in the amount of \$2,650.00. Motion carried.

**OPIOID SETTLEMENT:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to use any future funds from the National Opioid Settlement for uses allowed by the settlement agreement.

**REGISTER OF DEEDS:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to accept the Register of Deeds Statement of Fees for the month of April 2026 in the amount of \$4,076.15.

**SURPLUS PROPERTY:** Motioned by Preszler, seconded by Mehlhaff to declare 3.46 ton of scrap steel as surplus county property and allow the same to be sold to Meyers Tractor Salvage LLC. Motion carried.


